

FOOTBALL FUNDamentals LESSON 7 Year 2

Learning Intention: *How can you play a small sided game of football?*

Year 1:

I can play football in a team and be honest and follow the rules

I can play football follow the rules fairly and show respect to others

I can play football and begin to be a leader showing others how to play fairly, show respect and be honest with the rules

EQUIPMENT:

- 30 (enough for one each) size 4 footballs or medium-sized balls,
- Cones, spots

WARM UP: It's the Final!

Place cones in an area (set up with gates/goals)

Teacher to call out the following commands:

'Russo Run': Children to jog around, dribbling the ball

'Speedy Meady': Children dribble as quick as possible, scoring through the gates

'Captain Leah': Jump up and down, celebrating holding the cup!

'Toone': Children to do toe taps on the ball

'Keeper Earps': Children throw the ball up in the air and catch it



Euros Tournament

Sort the children into 6-8 European teams (Teams of 4/5):

England, France, Spain, Germany, Sweden Netherlands, Portugal, Norway

Set up 4-6 pitches (Depending on number of teams)

Round Robin - All teams will play each other.

Rules:

Set up lots of small pitches as show in the picture. 5 v 5 small sided games

Rules:

Start the Game:

- A kick-off is taken at the **centre** of the playing area to start the game and after a goal has been scored
- At kick-off, you must pass to a player on your team
- Whoever scores - The opposite team is then given the ball to restart the game.

Out of Play:

- The ball is out of play - When the whole of the ball goes outside the of area (the cones)
- If the ball goes off at the sideline- A 'throw in' is taken
- If the ball goes off the goal line from an attacking player (player trying to score) it is a goal kick
- If the ball goes off the goal line from a defending player (player trying to stop you scoring) it is a corner

Foul:

- If you kick another player and not the ball - The other team is given the ball
- If you pick up the ball with your hands - The other team is given the ball

Scoring:

- A goal is scored when the **whole** ball is kicked through the goal
